

What is Missoula Connect?


Now that you know who the MPO is, you might want to know what we're up to these days. While many design and construction projects are in the hopper—and you can check them out at www.missoulampo.com—we're also taking some time to think about our future. One of the Missoula-area's largest planning projects that will be underway in 2020 is an update to our Long-Range Transportation Plan (LRTP), which we're calling Missoula Connect.

The federal government requires that we prepare a long-range transportation plan every four years. Why, you might ask? Good question.

The LRTP is a 30-year plan that looks at all modes of transportation and identifies future priorities for projects and funding. Missoula is on the move and we need to ensure we're not only keeping pace but staying ahead.

To do that, the MPO works with regional partners to coordinate priorities and projects. While we are a community with big ideas, we also live in a state with limited transportation funding. It's the MPO's responsibility to help document changing needs and priorities to match funding allocations with our regional goals.

We need your help to ensure that the LRTP prioritizes investments that respond to the needs of the community. There will be many opportunities to get involved in our work, and we'll provide more information in the coming weeks and months.
